DEPARTURE TIMES: Departure is from 6-7pm on Friday evening. There is the option to stay until Saturday morning but there will be no staff or services available after 7pm on Friday. If you are

staying until Saturday morning, please fill out the form in the online registration portal 2 weeks prior to the start of Family Camp.

CAMP LOCATION: Use 500 Lutherlyn Lane, Butler PA 16001 for GPS directions.

SPENDING MONEY: Lutherlyn has a camp store that will be open daily during the camp week. Items available included: shirts and other clothing, candy, juice, post cards, etc. Family campers may use a camp store account or cash at the camp store. THE CRAFT CABIN DOES NOT ACCEPT CASH – YOU MUST SET UP A STORE ACCOUNT FOR THE CRAFT CABIN. Camp Store Accounts can be set up in the online portal or at check-in on Sunday.

CAMP FEES: Camp fees and all online forms are due by June 15th.

CANCELLATION POLICY: \$20 of each registration is non-refundable (due to processing fees and other expenses incurred by Lutherlyn). \$80 of the deposit is refundable until June 1st. After June 1st the \$100 deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. The final payment is due two weeks before coming to camp. Camp fees are not refundable or transferable for cancellations made within two weeks of the scheduled session except for medical reasons. The fee for campers leaving camp for medical reasons or family emergencies may be refunded on a pro-rated basis.

HEALTH HISTORY FORM: A Health History Form must be completed by June 15th in your online account for each member of the family.

HEALTH CARE INFORMATION: The health and safety of each camper is of the utmost importance. Campers will receive a brief health screening at check-in. A camp nurse/health care provider is on duty 24-hours/day, cabin leaders are trained and certified in First Aid and CPR, the "Health Hut" is equipped to care for the medical needs of campers and staff, and the local hospital and ambulance service are quickly available. All campers, volunteers, and staff MUST have a current health record on file at Lutherlyn prior to staying at camp.

Please take the health and well-being of others, particularly those who may have compromised immune systems, into consideration when evaluating your own health prior to a retreat/event at Lutherlyn. While we certainly would love to have you here, we do not want others to get sick while attending a retreat.

When sharing a cabin/sleeping space and meeting rooms with people from other households, it is important to consider multiple factors prior to arriving at Lutherlyn. If you have symptoms that indicate you could have a contagious illness (fever, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, congestion, etc.) that could transmit to others, please cancel your registration for a refund. Lutherlyn will issue a refund for ALL medical related cancellations.

Anyone who tests positive for or is diagnosed with a respiratory viral illness (such as COVID-19, influenza, and RSV) with onset of symptoms within 5 days prior to the start of camp, should cancel for a full refund. To come to camp after having a respiratory viral illness, you must be at least 5 days past the onset of symptoms, 48 hours fever free, and have no symptoms or mild and improving symptoms.

We recommend participants take a rapid COVID test prior to departing for Lutherlyn. If symptoms develop while at Lutherlyn, please refrain from interacting with others, notify the camp administration, and depart from Lutherlyn. A pro-rated refund will be issued.
