**CHECK-IN TIME:** The cabins will be ready for you to move in at 2:00pm on Sunday. Check-in is on the Dining Hall Porch from 2:30-4:00pm on Sunday afternoon. Payment of any remaining balance is expected at this time. Arrangements for guests should be made at this time.

- 7:15 Worship on Chapel Hill
- 8:00 S'Mores & Campfire on Chapel Hill (bring a chair or blanket if you wish)
- 9:00 Snacks and board games in Dining Hall

**DEPARTURE TIMES:** Departure is from 6-7pm on Friday evening. There is the option to stay until Saturday morning but there will be no staff or services available after 7pm on Friday. If you are staying until Saturday morning, please fill out the form in the online registration portal by June 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**CAMP LOCATION:** Lutherlyn is located south of Prospect, PA on DICK ROAD, 1.5 miles off Highway 422. Go to www.lutherlyn.com for more detailed directions. Use 500 Lutherlyn Lane, Butler for GPS directions.

**SPENDING MONEY:** Lutherlyn has a camp store that will be open daily during the camp week. Items available included: shirts and other clothing, candy, juice, post cards, etc. Family campers may use a camp store account or cash at the camp store. THE CRAFT CABIN DOES NOT ACCEPT CASH – YOU MUST SET UP A STORE ACCOUNT FOR THE CRAFT CABIN. Camp Store Accounts can be set up in the online portal or at check-in on Sunday.

**CAMP FEES:** Camp fees and all online forms are due by June 16<sup>th</sup>.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Camp fees are not refundable for cancellations made within two weeks of the scheduled session except for medical reasons. Fee for campers leaving their sessions may be refunded on a pro-rated basis only if departure is due to medical reasons.

**HEALTH HISTORY FORM:** A Health History Form must be completed by June 16<sup>th</sup> in your online account for each member of the family.

**HEALTH CARE INFORMATION:** The health and safety of each camper is of the utmost importance. Campers will receive a brief health screening at check-in. A camp nurse/health care provider is on duty 24-hours/day, cabin leaders are trained and certified in First Aid and CPR, the "Health Hut" is equipped to care for the medical needs of campers and staff, and the local hospital and ambulance service are quickly available. All campers, volunteers, and staff MUST have a current health record on file at Lutherlyn prior to staying at camp.

Please take the health and well-being of others, particularly those who may have compromised immune systems, into consideration when evaluating your health prior to arrival at Lutherlyn. While we certainly would love to have you here, we do not want others to get sick while attending camp. Lutherlyn will issue a full refund for ALL medical related cancellations. If anyone in your family has any of the following conditions, please call the camp office to cancel your week at camp.

- Fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or persistent cough within 24 hours of coming to camp.
- Head lice or scabies within 1 week of coming to camp.
- A contagious condition that has been treated by an antibiotic for less than 24 hours.
- Tested positive for COVID-19 with onset of symptoms within 5 days prior to the start of camp. To come to summer camp after having COVID you must be at least 5 days past the onset of symptoms, 48 hours fever free, and have no symptoms or mild and improving symptoms.

If a camper presents symptoms of COVID-19, the flu, RSV, strep, or other contagious conditions while at camp, they will stay quarantined and plan to depart Lutherlyn.
